Filmmaker Ken O'Sullivan has spent a lifetime filming in Ireland's natural environment. He's produced and filmed documentaries such as Dolphins: Wonder of the Ocean

An engaging speaker, he discusses the trials and tribulations of wildlife filmmaking, why Irish programmes have to compete on the world stage and why he can't do anything else.

Kara discusses how she combines sound data and journalism and the audience gets to hear novel sounds from nature.
